

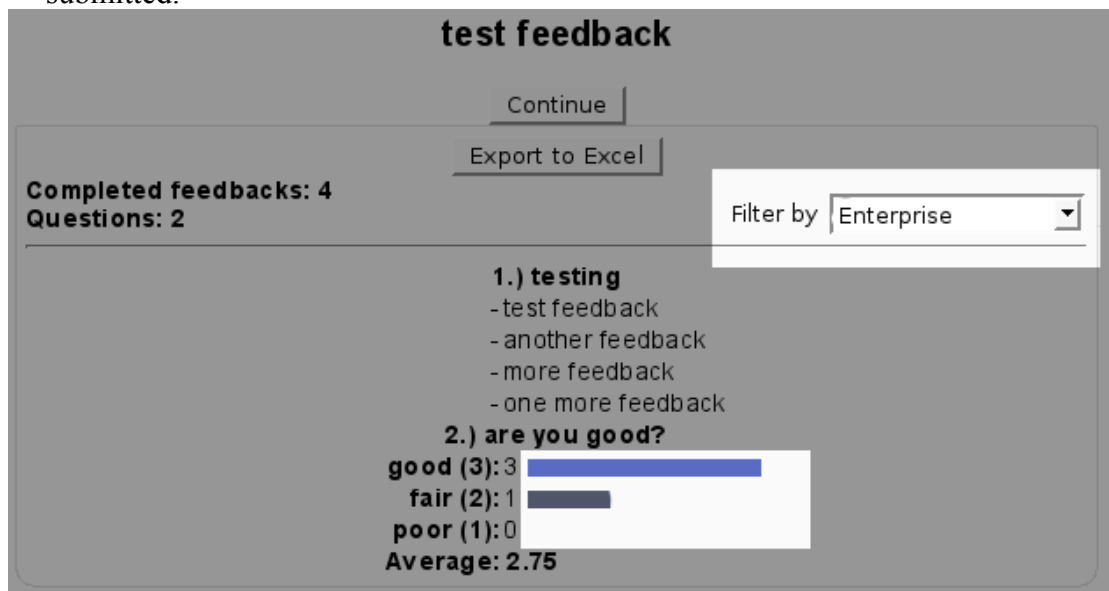
Changes to Feedback module

Described here are the changes to be done on the feedback module:

- Create a block that will be present on all courses that list the different feedback available to the students. This will allow easy access to feedback



- Add graphs to rate question type similar to survey.net.nz.
- Add a filter mechanism to filter by enterprise, category and course. Its likely that a dropdown UI may not suit moodle with lots of courses. So maybe a separate page to pick which category and courses to filter the report is needed. This feature will require some database changes, as we need to track what context a response was submitted.

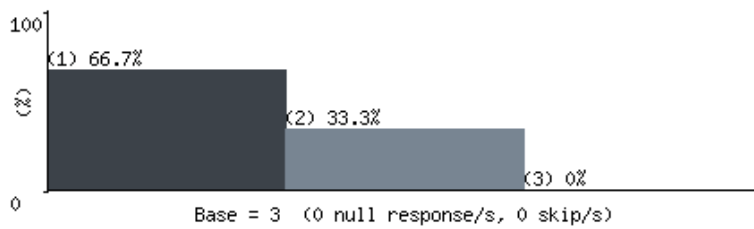
