Moodle Dataform

Entry Choice

(Dataform 2.7.3, 2.8.1)

Purpose

 With the entry choice feature the teacher can allow students to choose and take ownership on predefined entries.

Uses:

- Selecting preferred assignment from a given set.
- Registering to sessions.
- Etc.

Usage

- The pattern [[EAU:assignme]] of the Entry Author field, displays 'Assign me' and 'Unassign me' buttons in applicable entries.
- By clicking the 'Assign me' button the student becomes the entry owner.
- By clicking the 'Unassign me' button the student returns ownership to the teacher.
- Students can assign to entries up to the max entries as configured in the activity settings.
- Students cannot assign themselves to entries already owned by other students.

Steps

- 1. Create a Dataform activity for entry choice.
- 2. Add an entries for the students to select.
- 3. Students enter the activity and assign themselves to entries.

1. Create the Dataform activity

Fields

- No special fields are required for the entry choice function.
- You can add fields for providing info on the project/assignment as needed.
- You can add fields for grading if the project/assignment will be graded.

1. Create the Dataform activity

Views

- It may be useful to have separate views for
 - Adding the predefined entries (Teacher access only)
 - Entries selection where students can select entries.
 - Project view where students can work on the selected entries. This view can be filtered to show only the current student's entries.
- Add other views as required.

2. Add entries for selection

- Add entries for students' selection.
- You can use the CSV view to bulk import entries.
- You can also use the ##addnewentries## pattern, to add multiple new entries in one go.


3. Students choose entries

- Logged in as a student
 - Enter the activity.
 - Go to the entries selection view.
 - Click the 'Assign me' button of an entry to select this entry.
 - If you want to change your selection, click the 'Unassign me' button of the entry. Then click the 'Assign me' button of another entry.
 - Note: entries that do not have an 'Assign me' button have already been selected by other students.


4. Illustration

- A Dataform activity set to max 2 entries.
- 5 predefined entries entered by the teacher.
- Student 1 selects 2 entries.
- Student 1 selects 2 entries.


Student 1 has not yet selected any entries.



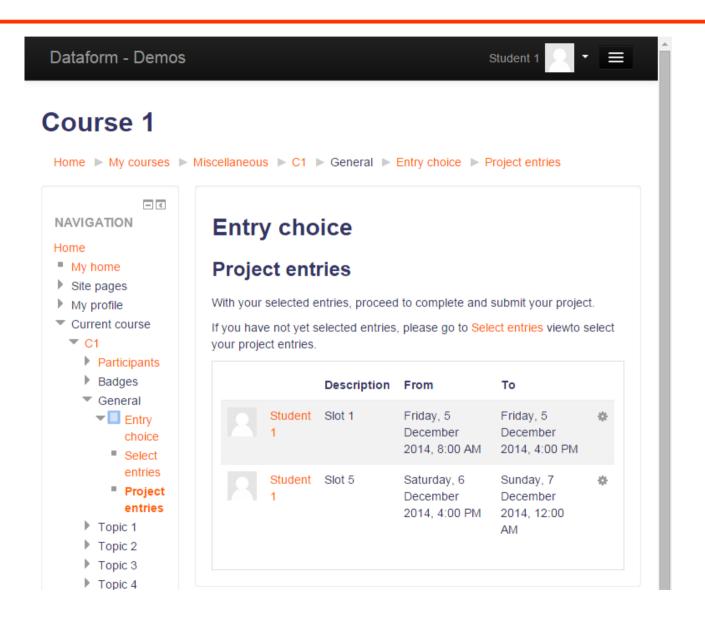
In the Selection view Student 1 can select available entries.




Student 1 selected Slots 1 and 5. Since the activity is set to max 2 entries, all the other entries become unavailable for this student. The student can change his/her selection by unassigning him/her self from a slot and selecting another one.



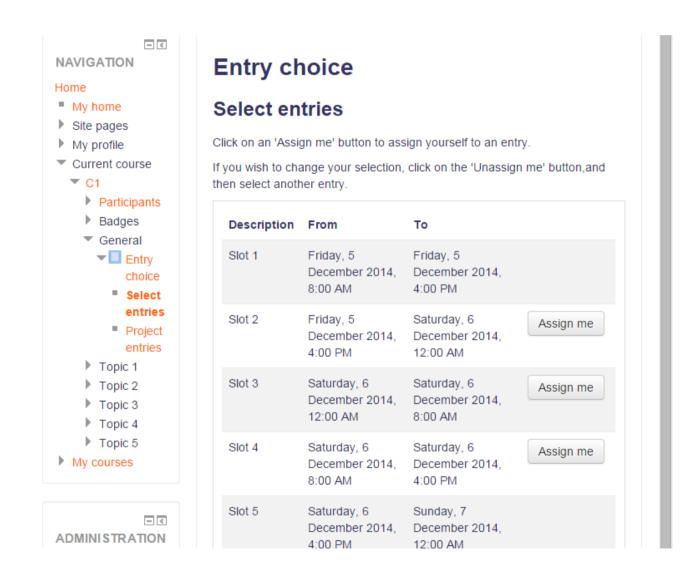
Student 1 can now see the selected entries in the Project entries view.



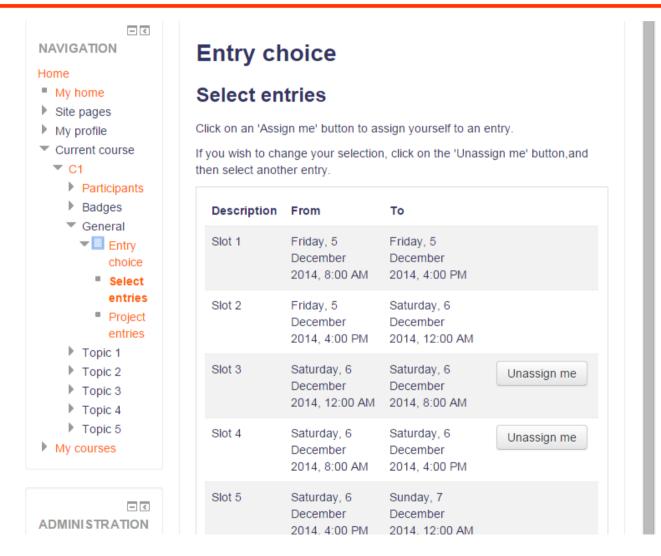
Student 2 has not yet selected any entries.



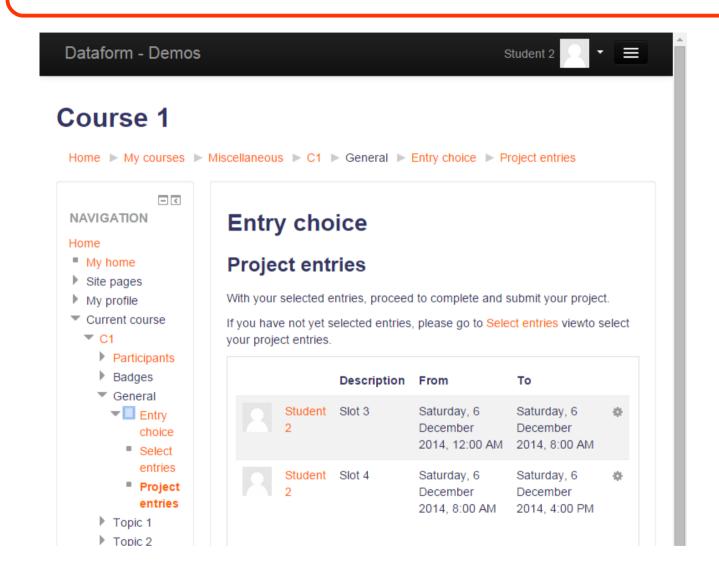
In the Selection view Student 2 can select available entries. Slots 1 and 5 have already been selected by another student, and therefore unavailable.



Student 2 selected Slots 3 and 4. Since the activity is set to max 2 entries, all the other entries become unavailable for this student. The student can change his/her selection by unassigning him/her self from a slot and selecting another one.



Student 2 can now see the selected entries in the Project entries view.
